This is a paid development opportunity for young professional dancers, to interact with today's choreographic talent to create new work and gain visibility in the London dance community and to perform at a showcase in the Clore Studio ROH, and public performances at Sadler's Wells Lilian Baylis Theatre.

We are looking for exceptional male and female dancers aged between 18 and 26 with very strong classical technique and partnering ability for this Summer Project.

The Summer Choreography Project focuses on development and will include:

- Two weeks of 'Summer Choreographics' In a new collaboration between NEBT and The Royal Ballet, you will work at the Royal Opera House with a range of choreographers over a two week period.
- NEBT Choreography Lab A development of three short new choreographic works by emerging choreographers.
- Choreography development of a work by choreographer Daniela Cardim (this work will form part of NEBT's 2020 season)
- Professional Dancers Development Programme including coaching from our world-class patrons, lectures in psychology for dance and nutrition.
- NEBT sharing performance The works will be presented to an invited dance industry audience at the Clore Studio, Royal Opera House.
- Public Performances at Sadler's Wells Lilian Baylis Theatre 3rd 6th September 2019.
